

PHRYNOHYAS VENULOSA (NCN). MÉXICO: HIDALGO: Municipality of Huejutla de Reyes, Rancho Las Chacas, about 2.5 km NW downtown Huejutla ($21^{\circ}10'N$, $98^{\circ}24'W$), 700 m elev. 21 June 1993. Juan Alfonso Delgadillo Espinosa. Museo de Zoología, Facultad de Ciencias, UNAM, MZFC 6034. Verified by Antonio Hernandez. Found at a temporal pond (where breeding takes place) in grassland 50 m near to a river, where riparian vegetation exists (*Taxodium mucronatum*). *Smilisca baudini*, *Bufo valliceps*, and *B. marinus* were collected in the same habitat which suggests syntopy. First record for the state of Hidalgo and a southern range extension 40 km SE of nearest records in San Luis Potosí (Tamazunchale), Duellman (1970, The Hylid Frogs of Middle America. Univ. Kansas Mus. Nat. Hist. Monog. 1:1-765).
