

CHERSODROMUS LIEBMANNI (Liebmann's Earth Runner). MÉXICO: OAXACA: municipality of Santa María Pápalo, Peña Verde, 1800 m elev. 28 February 1994. Luis Canseco Márquez. Museo de Zoología, Facultad de Ciencias, Universidad Nacional Autónoma de México (MZFC 06842), female. Verified by Fernando Mendoza Quijano. First record for the state and a southern range extension of 118 km (airline) from Cuautlapan, Veracruz (Smith and Taylor 1945, Bull. U.S. Natl. Mus. 194:188). All specimens previously reported from Veracruz had a yellowish crossband behind parietal scales [Smith and Braestrup 1963, Herpetologica 18(4):233-240; Pérez-Higareda and Smith 1991, Inst. Biol. UNAM, México, 122 pp.] but the crossband is red on this specimen. This species was known previously only from the state of Veracruz [Smith 1943, Proc. U.S. Natl. Mus. 93(3169):343-504].
